- a. Why you want to participate in the program
- b. Your background in quantitative research
- c. Your background in qualitative research
- d. Your background in and additional needs for training in mixed methods research
- e. Your financial need for this scholarship
- f. How you intend to promote mixed methods research in your own field and/or home institution upon completion of the workshop

3. **Research Project Statement**

Please submit a ½ page single-spaced **research project statement** that includes:

- a. A draft title for your research project
- b. The problem being addressed in your project
- c. The types of quantitative and qualitative data that you will collect
- d. The purpose of your study (for example, a dissertation project, a university project, etc.)

4. **Additional Information Needed**

Please submit:

- a. a **letter of recommendation** from your supervisor outlining how you would benefit from attending the workshop
- b. a **letter/certificate** indicating proof of student or faculty status from your university or place of work.
